## Habitat® Multi-Purpose Ink Anti-Skin

Aerosol cans are for spray-paint. Unless you are tagging the walls of your pressroom, get rid of the old cans and breathe a little easier with Habitat's Multi-Purpose Ink Anti-Skin. Use it as an anti-skin for ink cans, as an ink train roller lubricant, a conventional ink tack reducer and ink film stability/transfer enhancer. Not only is Habitat versatile, 100% of the raw materials in Habitat Ink Anti-Skin are renewable resources from the U.S.A.

### ***Multi-Purpose Ink Anti-Skin Uses:***

1. As an anti-skin for ink cans, fountains and rollers use the spray atomizer to apply an even mist coat.
2. As an ink film stability enhancer add 1/8 – 1/4 ounce per pound of ink.
3. As a conventional ink tack reducer, begin by mixing 2 ounces per pound of ink and increase an ounce at a time until desired tack is achieved.
4. As an ink train roller lubricant, begin by washing up the unit. Next mist/apply a generous amount onto the rollers. Check rollers at hourly intervals to insure adequate film remains on the rollers.
